TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Hosted by Troy USBC

This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC). Any USBC certified tournament rule not specifically stated, waived or modified in these rules will apply where applicable.

1. Competition — Note: Lanes will be stripped and oiled before every squad

- Competition will consist of four-player Teams, Doubles, Singles and a nine-game All-Events (total of team, doubles and singles scores) . The bowler's first appearance in each event counts toward their All-Events total. The NYSUSBC is not responsible for obtaining bowlers for any of the events.
- No doubles only or singles only entries and no split entries. Bowlers must enter both doubles and singles. Doubles and singles games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes. Bowlers must enter and pay the All-Events fee prior to rolling their first ball in the tournament.
- No more than two players who identify themselves as professional bowlers will be allowed on the four-member TEAM; no more than one such player on a DOUBLES team. Professionals are eligible to enter singles and all-events. Note: Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director prior to the start of the squad. Assignments will be at random, any requests for pairings together can me made, but the NYSUSBC can't guarantee they will be honored. No scratch team may bowl unopposed.

2. Entrants

The NYS Women's Championships are open to all members in good standing of the USBC, NYSUSBC and a local NYSUSBC association and are conducted under USBC rules and regulations. Non-members of the NYSUSBC residing in New York State can become eligible by purchasing a USBC membership card for \$23. A non-resident of New York State who is eligible for state tournaments in her state of residency must have participated in a minimum of 21 games at the time of bowling, in a league in a USBC chartered local association in New York State to be eligible. A bowler holding a current USBC Intercollegiate Division membership sticker also is eligible.

3. Multiple Participation

You may bowl up to three times in Team, Doubles and Singles. No more than two players on a four-member team can place more than once in prize list (Rule 315). Doubles partners must change in order to cash more than once; Singles and All-Events cash only once. Scores bowled by an ineligible player or players will be disqualified.

4. Averages

Entrants shall use their highest USBC certified Standard, converted Challenge or converted Sport average, as a regular or substitute bowler, in the priority order listed below. Please indicate whether the average is from a Sport or Modified/Challenge League which is subject to re-rate and adjustment.

1. End of the 2022-23 and 2023-24 winter seasons (21 games or more);
2. End of the 2024 summer season (21 games or more);
3. As of April 1, 2025 for the current season (21 games or more) substantiated with a league standing sheet;
4. All others bowl scratch, and will be automatically entered in the scratch division.

Please note USBC Rules 319a-2&3, 319c, 319d and 319e will apply. The 10-Pin Rule will be in effect (as of April 1, 2025).

5. Handicap

Handicap for Divisions 2 & 3 will be determined using a Team Handicap Method. This will be based on 100% of the difference in the cumulative averages and 760 in the Team event, 380 in the Doubles event and 190 in the Singles event. Division 1 is scratch.

6. Classifications/Entry Fees

Entry fees must be paid in full when entry is submitted. Prizes will be awarded at 100% at a ratio of at least 1:6 Certified checks or personal checks or credit card only. Entries with partial fees will not be accepted All-Events are Optional. No refunds for cancelation with less than 48 hours notice.

7. Reservations

Reservations and Entry Forms are at www.bowlny.com. Reservations may be made up to January 1, 2025 for any weekend of the tournament except for Queens weekend (only Queens entries can make reservations). Entries and fees for reservations must be received by February 1, 2025.

8. Average Relief

Bowlers wanting to apply for relief of average due to injury or disability under provisions of USBC Rule 4e should apply a minimum of 30 days prior to bowling. Applications for relief of average (USBC Rule 4e) must be submitted in writing to NYSUSBC, Attn: Tournament Committee. Please see USBC Playing Rules for information regarding rule.

9. Prize Checks

The IRS requires USBC to furnish 1099 forms to individuals who accumulate winnings of \$600 or more annually in any NYSUSBC events in which they participate. Failure to furnish a Social Security number to NYSUSBC when requested may result in a 30% tax reduction of the prize check. Prize checks will be distributed within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament unless permission is granted to extend by USBC tournament certification.

10. Video/Photo Release

Bowlers competing in this tournament are subject to photographs and video recordings which may be displayed on social media or the internet.

11. Disclosure

Entrants whose names appear here or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the NYSUSBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning the prize portion and bowling fees of an entry if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NYSUSBC.

* USBC Online Registration fee is estimate to offset the cost of the bowlers paying online. Any extra fees after the money have been paid to USBC will be added to the prize fund.
