TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Adults must be certified members of USBC in New York State for the 2025-2026 season or have purchased an associate membership. We do not certify (sanction) onsite. Please certify with your local Association or on Bowl.com.
2. Junior participants must be USBC certified members of the New York State USBC, Inc . for the 2025-2026 season.
3. There will be four divisions:

Adult Female/ Junior Female	Adult Male/ Junior Male - 2 Classes
Adult Female/ Junior Male	Class A: 351 & Above
Adult/ Male/ Junior Female	Class B: 350 & Below
4. Handicap will be 90% of 440 in all divisions.
5. Multiple participation shall be unlimited with change of partners . Entrants will bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes. There will be scratch and handicap champions in each division.
6. Prize fee returned 100% in the form of scholarships depending on the number of entries. Ratio is 1 in 10.
7. Junior entrant - Each Junior bowler must submit a copy of his/her average verification in the form of aleague standing sheet or USBC website. Entrants will use their highest 2025-2026 USBC certified league average (including High School Certified Average) as of April 11, 2026 based on a minimum of 12 games or five (5) league sessions with a minimum of 10 games for entering purposes. Bowler who does not have 12 games or five (5) league sessions with a minimum of 10 games as of April 11, 2026, may use his/her highest current league average at the time of participation, based on minimum of 12 games or five (5) league sessions with a minimum of 10 games. Certified bowlers with no certified average for the current season, may use his/her highest certified league from 2024-2025 (including Summer league average) season based on a minimum of 15 games or five (5) league sessions with a minimum of 10 games. WRITTEN verification of the bowlers average entering average must be submitted. Certified bowlers with no acceptable average will be permitted to bowl with an entering average of 220. Any type of Sport Shot or modified Sport shot average will be subject to Re-Rating per USBC rules.
8. Adult entrant - Each adult bowler must submit a copy of his/her average verification, the association yearbook or average verification from league secretary if 4/11/26 certified average is being used. Entrants will use his/her highest USBC certified league average from the 2024-25 season based on a minimum of 15 games. If the adult does not have a 2024-25 season average, current certified average as of 4/11/26, based on a minimum of 15 games will be used. Those without acceptable averages will be permitted to bowl with an entering average of 220. USBC Rule 319e will apply. USBC Rule 319d will not apply. USBC Rule 319a-3 will apply. USBC Rule 319a-2 will not apply.
9. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to make decisions in any matters pertaining to the tournament not covered by the rules of USBC. All participants will abide by USBC Rule 400.
10. Walk-ons will be allowed if space permits. A walk-on/re-entry charge of \$5.00 per team will apply to those paying after 4/20/26. Walk-on charge will be used for additional awards - No Refunds. A returned check will incur an additional fee of \$40.
