TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Adults must be certified USBC members in New York State for the 2026–2027 season or have purchased an associate membership. Please certify through your local association or Bowl.com. On-site certification/sanctioning is not available.
2. Junior bowlers must be certified members of New York State USBC for the 2026–2027 season.
3. There will be four divisions: Adult Female/Junior Female; Adult Male/Junior Male; Adult Female/Junior Male; and Adult Male/Junior Female. The Adult Male/Junior Male division will include two classes: Class A, 351 and above; and Class B, 350 and below.
4. Handicap will be 90% of 440 for all divisions.
5. Multiple participation is unlimited with a change of partners. Entrants will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Scratch and handicap champions will be recognized in each division.
6. Prize fees will be returned 100% as scholarships, based on the number of entries. The payout ratio is 1 in 10. Scholarships will be administered through the USBC SMART Program, Account #10118.
7. Written verification of the entering average must be submitted. Certified bowlers without an acceptable average may bowl with an entering average of 220. Sport Shot or modified Sport Shot averages may be subject to re-rating under USBC rules.
8. **Junior entrants** must submit average verification, such as a league standing sheet or USBC website record. For entry purposes, juniors will use their highest 2026–2027 USBC-certified league average, including high school certified averages, as of April 11, 2027, based on at least 12 games or five league sessions with at least 10 games. Bowlers who do not meet that requirement as of April 11, 2026, may use their highest current league average at the time of participation, based on at least 12 games or five league sessions with at least 10 games. Certified bowlers without a current-season certified average may use their highest certified league average from the 2025–2026 season, including summer league, based on at least 15 games or five league sessions with at least 10 games.
9. **Adult entrants** will use their highest USBC-certified league average from the 2025–2026 season, based on at least 15 games. If an adult does not have a 2025–2026 average, their current certified average as of April 11, 2027, based on at least 15 games, will be used. USBC Rules 319a-3 and 319e apply; USBC Rules 319a-2 and 319d do not apply.
10. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to decide any matters not covered by USBC rules. All youth participants must comply with USBC Rule 400.
11. **Any bowler who fails to provide average verification within 10 days after the tournament ends will be entered with an average of 220.**
12. Walk-ons will be allowed if space permits. No refunds will be issued after April 28, 2027. Returned checks will incur a \$40 fee.
