

Amendments to NYS USBC Bylaws

The Following Amendments are proposed to the NYS USBC Bylaws based on mandatory changes from USBC to State Bylaws

Change to time limit for submitting qualifications for nomination from the floor –

Article V Board of Directors – Management - Section C Eligibility

2019-2020 Bylaws

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, ***at least thirty (30) days*** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

2021- 2022 Bylaws – updated for USBC Mandatory changes

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, at least 24 hours, or up to seven (7) days prior to the opening of the annual meeting as determined by the delegates.
Qualifications are due **24 hours** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

Proposed Update

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, at least 24 hours, or up to seven (7) days prior to the opening of the annual meeting as determined by the delegates.
Qualifications are due **7 days** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

Article VI: Officers Section B: Election

2019-2020 Bylaws

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, ***at least thirty (30) days*** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

2021- 2022 Bylaws – updated for USBC Mandatory changes

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, at least 24 hours, or up to seven (7) days prior to the opening of the annual meeting as determined by the delegates.
Qualifications are due **24 hours** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

Proposed Update

Qualifications must be submitted, in writing, at least 24 hours, or up to seven (7) days prior to the opening of the annual meeting as determined by the delegates.

Qualifications are due **7 days** prior to the opening of the Annual Meeting.

Article VII: Meetings – Section A: Annual Meeting - change due to elimination of the term Youth Director

2019-2020 Bylaws

7. Quorum.

The Board, Adult Delegates representing Adult members and Youth Delegates determine the number.

- a. ***Twenty-Five (25) Adult Delegates representing adult membership constitute a quorum.***
- b. ***Fifteen (15) Youth Delegates constitute a quorum for Youth.***

7. Quorum. 40 board members constitute a quorum. The board and delegates determine the number.
